The CCS project of Yara and Northern Lights: a "liquid bridge" between the Netherlands and Norway

Abstract :

At the end of 2023, the first binding cross-border trade agreement for the transport and storage of CO₂ was signed between Yara Sluiskil, one of the world's leading players in ammonia and fertilizers, and Northern Lights, a provider of CO₂ transportation and storage. Operations at the Yara site will begin in 2026, accomplishing a reduction in annual CO₂ emissions of 800,000 tonnes from Yara Sluiskil ammonia production.
