

Biography

Giorgio Veronesi is President of Aidic Servizi.

Born in Bassano del Grappa (VI) in 1954, he graduated with honors in Chemical Engineering from the University of Padua in 1979. He has worked for over 40 years in the field of Engineering and Construction.

He began his career in 1981 at Foster Wheeler, moving from Project Engineering to Project Management and finally to the management of profit centers. He was responsible for companies in their start-up phase (in Singapore, Italy, and Russia) or in their maturity (Foster Wheeler France), thus dealing with very different challenges. Giorgio Veronesi joined Maire Engineering, later Tecnimont, in 2007, with the role of Vice President Commercial and responsibility for sales and proposals in the energy and infrastructure sectors, with particular focus on EPC power projects.

From 2011 to 2012 he was Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Siirtec Nigi SpA, a Process Engineering Contractor based in Milan, specialized in sulfur removal and gas treatment, with the task of reorganizing the company through the creation of a new operating unit, new governance, management procedures, etc.

Since the end of 2012 he has been Commercial Manager at Techint SpA in Milan and has worked mainly on projects in the O&G sector in Africa, Iran, and Russia. Since 2018 he has held this role part time. Since January 2019 he has also been a technical consultant to Chimitrade SpA and Imagro SpA, Milan.

Since January 2016 Giorgio Veronesi has been on the Board of EFCE (the European Federation of Chemical Engineering), of which he has been Executive Vice President since January 2018. In September 2021 he was appointed President of EFCE; his mandate will expire on 31/12/2025.

Since November 2020 Giorgio Veronesi has been a member of the Executive Board of CIUZ (Italian-Uzbekistan Chamber of Commerce) and has been its President since January 2022.
